

## **Guide to Eugene**

We are very excited to welcome you to Eugene, Oregon this winter for the **Craft Brewery Startup Workshop!** In an effort to make your visit more enjoyable, we have put together this guide to Eugene. The guide includes information on hotel reservations, transportation and helpful links.

## Getting to and around Eugene

If you are flying into Portland Airport (PDX) you can rent a car from a number of rental car companies or reserve the Hut Shuttle. If you are flying into the Eugene Airport, it is conveniently located 15 minutes from downtown Eugene. There are a variety of transportation options upon arrival to Eugene listed here. Furthermore, there is a bus and commuter service, Lane Transit District (https://www.ltd.org).

## Where to Stay

There are a number of options for you to explore while staying in Eugene. You can find a list of hotels on Kayak, Travelocity, Priceline, or at similar discount websites. VRBO.com or Airbnb.com are alternative options to hotels.

The first three days of the Craft Brewery Startup Workshop will take place at Lane Community College's Center for Meeting and Learning - Downtown Campus. Please note that this is **NOT** the tasting room for Ninkasi Brewing Company but the administration building. The entrance into the building is through the dock sales entrance. Parking: there is plenty of free parking in their parking lot or on the street in front of the building.
